PROTOCOL TESTS WITH SALLY EVANS:

A limited number of 30 minutes sessions will be on offer to all SDC members.

Ride one of the prescribed tests in front of judge, Sally Evans.

After riding the test, discuss your test with Sally and then re-ride the test or movements using Sally's feedback.

Learn how to improve your marks, all in a low stress and encouraging environment!

PROTOCOL TESTS:

1. Preparatory C
2. Preliminary 1A
3. Novice 2A
4. Elementary 3A
5. Medium 4A
6. Advanced & Above - Test of choice

We are so lucky to have a Grand Prix rider and an A Level Judge, **Sally Evans**, available for our Protocol Day.

Sally is a very experienced, motivating and extremely knowledgeable judge.

INDEPENDENT USE OF DRESSAGE ARENA:

Train independently in a 60x20m dressage arena.

30 minute time slots from 9am to 3pm. Pick your time and ride.

INDEPENDENT USE OF GROUNDS (NO ARENA):

Train independently on the grounds anytime from 9am to 3pm on the grounds (not in an arena).

COSTS:

Protocol Tests: \$30 per test

Individual use of the grounds: \$10 per horse

Independent use of dressage arena: \$20 per horse

All costs payable with entries.



EVENT HELP

We kindly ask for our afternoon riders (12 noon to 3pm) to help pack away arenas.
This event cannot run without member's help.

HEALTH HORSE DECLARATIONS:

Must be handed in at the Rotunda upon arrival.

Blank forms can be found on SDC's website and will be emailed to riders with the time draw.

Conditions of Entry:

1. This event will be run in accordance with the rules of the EA
2. All entries must go to Nominate.com.au
3. Afternoon riders from 12 - 3pm are asked to please stay and help pack away.
4. All riders must be current members of SDC.
5. Current EA approved and tagged safety helmets must be worn by all competitors when mounted and lunging.
6. Gloves to be worn and collared T-Shirts with sleeves.
7. T-Shirts, saddlecloths and breeches can be of any colour. Jackets and plaiting are not required.
8. Riders, handlers and anyone coaching must be a member of Summerland Dressage Club.
9. No lunging in the main showground area/ring (use designated area).
10. No horses are to be led in the main showground area/ring when other's are mounted .
11. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times
12. Only horses entered in the event are allowed on the grounds
13. The club's committee has the rights to alter the conditions of entry
14. Health Horse Declarations must be handed in at the Rotunda area upon arrival.
15. If this event is cancelled or postponed 20% of the entry fee will be retained to cover costs. There will be no refund of money after the closing date of entries, except on production of a Veterinary or Doctor's Certificate within seven (7) days after the event - then only 10% will be retained to cover club costs.
16. In consideration of the SDC Inc accepting an entry, riders and/or owners will undertake NOT to hold the committee or members of the SDC Inc responsible for any claims, losses, suits or damages. All riders and/or owners should fully understand that they compete at their own risk. Your signature on the entry form confirms that you understand and accept the conditions of entry.
